You will have knowledge of current legislation relating to safeguarding practice, and demonstrate a good understanding of the structure and operation of statutory and voluntary bodies involved in safeguarding. It would be helpful to have knowledge of the Church of England and its structures. You will need effective assessment, reporting and communication skills, combined with sensitivity and discretion. The post will be based at the Diocesan Offices near London Bridge, with some opportunities for working from home.
