### 18 to 26 June – Croydon Heritage Festival 2016

We are participating again in the Festival this year, which also coincides with our own Patronal Festival. The events programme is as follows:

**Saturday 18 June:** Three Choirs Festival marking the start of our Patronal Festival – more details available under the tower.

**Monday 20 to Friday 24 June:** a programme of special musical events, services and heritage talks and tours – more details coming soon.

**Saturday 25 June:** Croydon Minster Heritage Open Day (10.30am to 4pm) with tours of the church and tower, stalls, refreshments, plus music including a short informal concert at 2.30pm from the Minster's Youth Choir, the Scola Cantorum. Tower tours will be at 11am, 12.00noon and 2pm.

This year we will also be commemorating 100 years since the First World War, with a display and exhibition entitled "The Great War and Croydon Minster". Find out more about the part played by Croydon's Parish Church in the war and see some genuine WWI artefacts.
