### Minster income problem

At our PCC Meeting last Wednesday, our treasurers highlighted that we are running at a serious deficit, even though we met our target for the 'Clear it for Fr Colin' campaign earlier in the year. They pointed out that whilst we are continuing to keep a tight grip on expenditure our donations income is way below what we budgeted for from the same period as last year. If this trend keeps up, by the end of the 2016 we may be down by about £20,000. So, please can we encourage you to:
