Organ Restoration Appeal

We are delighted to share more good news in respect of the Organ Appeal. The total amount received/pledged now stands at **£218,586** so we really are in touching distance of our £250,000 target. Individual donations, some of which have been very generous, have continued to come in over the first 4 months of this year, but the main reason why our total has leapt up now is due to an injection of funding that we will be receiving soon from the Church Tenements Charity. As you may know, this is the Charity that provides annual funding to the Minster's Fabric Fund and the trustees decided this week to award funding of **£55,200** to the Minster to use for the Organ Appeal. We thank God for this windfall which has come to us at just the right moment to boost our Appeal. Gail and Karen.
