17-23 June is 'Refugee Week'. We are asked to pray for all refugees, celebrating their contribution to this nation and creating a welcoming environment for them. One response locally is the Croydon Refugee Centre. We have receive this message from them "Can I first of all thank you for your ongoing support and prayers for our work with Refugees and Asylum Seekers in the borough. Demand for our services is constantly rising and we have already seen more than 500 new people [including children] so far this year – almost double the amount we welcomed during the first five months last year. And we're

just starting to struggle in terms of resources. We've totally run out of tinned tuna, tinned tomatoes and tinned fruit; and financial support has also started to drop. We would appreciate any assistance you might be able to offer to help us meet the many and varied needs of those who come to us for assistance."
